The money was spent in the following ways:

### Impact

The sports premium has had a big impact on reviving the sporting life at St. Paul's. Our new PE Leader, Mr Trickett continued to enthusiastically promote playtime challenges with awards in Celebration Assembly, and continued to develop the school's football team, who were showing clear signs of improvement by the end of the season, as we began winning matches. The team were coached once a week by Jez Ranger, who teaches PE in PPA time. Gaynor Turner, who also teaches PE in PPA time, taught the netball team that participated in the netball league. The team were very successful getting into the finals at the end of term.

The Bacon's Partnership has created a number of opportunities for St. Paul's School. Aside from the rugby, football and netball leagues, they also provided competitions for all year groups from 1- 6 to participate in. Groups of children were taken to football and athletics tournaments from across the school. The children were very successful in the athletics tournament in most phases, and have been motivated by some sporting success. This was enhanced by the effort that our very enthusiastic PE Leader, Mr Trickett, put into sport in school. Every week in Celebration Assembly, he has rewarded pupils who have represented the school, or been shown trying to meet his weekly PE challenge. Unfortunately Mr Trickett left the school in July 2016, and he will be missed, but Miss Pollard is taking over this area of responsibility.

**Plans for the year 2016-17 include the development of netball as a sport. This will entail the cost of the coach as well as buying equipment for netball.**
