## Sports Premium Report 2014-15

The income from the Sports Premium was £9,000 in the year 2014-15.

The money was spent in the following ways:

Subscription to Bacon's College for consultancy, training and provision of extra curricular activities, plus hockey coach for a term	£6,500
Hockey equipment, basketball hoops, fitness equipment, balls	£1,200
Swimming lessons for all KS2 (contribution to the £4000 this costs annually)	£1,200
Football kit for the school football team	£100
Total	£9,000

### Impact

The sports premium has had a big impact on reviving the sporting life at St. Paul's. Our new PE co-ordinator, Mr Trickett has enthusiastically introduced playtime challenges with awards in Celebration Assembly, and is developing the school's football team, who were showing clear signs of improvement by the end of the season, as we began winning matches. The team were coached once a week by Mr Trickett, and Mr Alam coached a Year 5 team who played some friendly matches with Grange School, which will hopefully get the 2015-16 team off to a good start.

There was also a Year 6 basketball team, and Mr Trickett coached this team after the football season ended. There is a shortage of time to coach all the teams we would like, due to demands on teachers to fulfil other duties, and therefore we will pay for a coach from the Sports Premium to develop a school netball team in 2015-16. The school is employing PE specialists to deliver PE during PPA time for teachers for several classes, although all teachers deliver another PE lesson, ensuring they keep up their skills.

The hockey coach gave the chance for children to receive expert tuition in this sport, and the school now has the equipment, for use in other PE lessons. In addition, there are other after school club opportunities in school, not paid for by Sports Premium, such as Dance Club and Football Club, ensuring that pupils have plenty of opportunities to explore their physical activities and develop their talents.

**Plans for the year 2015-16 include the development of netball as a sport. This will entail the cost of the coach as well as buying equipment for netball.**
