## Internet Safety

Top tips include:

- Having an open and honest conversation with your children, about how they use the internet, and what they enjoy doing on-line. Conversation starters are on the website to help you start this discussion. Discuss this regularly with your children.
- Create a family agreement. There is an example on the website, to help you think about your internet use as a family, to make sure everyone stays safe on-line.
- Take a look at your accounts, whether gaming, social media or email. Check privacy settings and consider deactivating or deleting accounts no longer in use.
- Know how to report and block – look at the different options, so that everybody feels confident in using them
- Play and use the internet together – this helps everyone learn about developing skills to use the internet safely
- Get involved in Safer Internet Day on 6<sup>th</sup> February, by registering as a supporter and downloading the free resources and videos on the website.
