This is a new part of the weekly newsletter following parents' feedback at the Ofsted Parent's meeting. We will keep you informed of changes and ask for your suggestions via the weekly newsletter and the parents' noticeboard in the KS1 playground. Please check these regularly.

The school has already begun work on improving areas of teaching and learning based on outcomes from the Ofsted report. So far some of the actions have included:

- Rewriting the Maths, Reading, Writing, Phonics and Early Year policies so they are user friendly and have clear consistent expectations for all staff. You can find these on the schools website under Key Info and School Policies
- Senior Leaders are having individual meetings with class teachers to look at strategies for improving outcomes for all children in the class.

We will also be formulating the action plan for Ofsted in the next week. We will share the content of this through future newsletters and the parents' noticeboard.
