School Improvement Focus: Inclusion and Special Needs

This year we are introducing a new Inclusion Team for the school. Our aim is to enable children to confidently access all aspects of school. The team will be working closely with the class teachers and families. Mrs Gadd will be leading the team supported by Miss Case (Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator), Miss Donna M (Learning Mentor), Miss Linda May (English as an Additional Language Assistant) and Miss Donna G (Attendance Officer). We welcome Mr JJ to St Paul's, he is well known in the community and will be working with children to improve their behaviour. The team meets once a fortnight.

To meet all the additional needs of the children, we would appreciate your help with the following requests:

- 1. If your child has asthma, please complete a school asthma sheet (available from the office) and provide the school with a spare pump.
- 2. If your child has an allergy and an epi-pen at home, we also need to know about the allergy and it is essential to have an epi-pen in school for your child.
- 3. If your child follows a specific diet for either medical or religious reasons, please put this in writing to the office, so your child's details can be updated.

We look forward to working with you. If you have any questions, please do talk to us on the playground before and after school, or make an appointment via the school office.

Meet the Teacher: Our thanks to all the parents who have shown their support and interest in the meet the teacher meetings. Families and schools working in partnership will enable the best outcomes for our children.

The last classes: MAPLE, BIRCH & ASH are invited to meet the teacher on Wednesday 19th September. This informal meeting is a chance to find out about your child's curriculum, the expectations for the class and to ask any questions. Please go to your child's class for a 3.30pm start – your child will be able to show you where to go, if you are unsure.

Harvest Service - Thursday 20th September: Our school will be collecting food for the Manna Centre at London Bridge with St Paul's Church. The Manna Centre is a drop in centre for homeless people. Please could children bring: sugar, coffee, tinned tomatoes, rice (new packets securely packed), tinned hot dogs, pasta, tinned fruit or breakfast cereal. Please NO clothes, toys etc.

Choir: Well done to the children who successfully auditioned for the choir. To ensure the children can take part in sports fixtures (currently on Thursday) and singing, Mrs Jones has kindly moved Choir to Friday.

After School Club: We offer childcare after school. Our after school provision is from the end of the school day until 6pm and costs £6.00 per day. Children do a wide range of activities during the club and are provided with a hot meal. Please see Miss Madge if you would like to book a place for your child.


