### Year 2 outcomes

We are pleased to tell you that our Year 2 cohort (in Ash and Birch class) have completed all their SATs assessments in Reading and Writing now and have done very well as the school has met targets predicted at the beginning of the year. We are very proud of our Year 2 staff team and the children as they have worked hard all year to achieve this. Please look out for official percentages in each subject of Reading, Writing and Maths, in future newsletters. These will be included once we have the Year 6 results, so the middle of July. These results will also go on the website.

### Assessment Week

Next week is assessment for Year 1 and Year 3-5. The children will sit tests for Maths and Reading and teachers will use this to inform the achievement your child has made this year. Writing is assessed through looking at longer and shorter pieces of writing in the children's English, Topic, RE and Science books throughout the year. Achievement in Reading, Writing and Maths will be shared in end of year reports, which go out on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2019. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time next week and well rested as this will ensure they are ready for their tests.

### Year 6

Please note that Year 6 children who are going on residential need to be at school at 8.15am. Please come to the main office and meet in the hall.

When they return from Residential Week Year 6 will be learning about the emotional, social and physical aspects of growing up and relationships in small groups over the next few weeks. If you would like to know more detail about the content of these sessions please see your child's class teacher.

### After School Club Places available:

We have a number of Breakfast and After School Clubs available from September. If you would like to book your places please speak to Miss Denise or Miss Madge our After School Club supervisor, who will take your names and begin a list of interested parents. Confirmation of your place/s will be given to you by letter by the end of the summer term. From September Breakfast and After School prices will be as follows:

Breakfast Club: £2 (this club will now run from 7.45-8.30am rather than 8-8.30am)

After School: £10

### **Changes to clubs next year**

We are currently working on developing a wider range of clubs and booster classes for next academic year. We will have a mixture of teacher, teaching assistant and professional coaches who will lead a wide range of clubs. For these clubs to go ahead we need at least 15 children and will be asking for £2 per session. Monies for clubs will be paid ahead of the club starting. Clubs will run for a term at a time and will run from 3.15pm – 4.15pm. Please note, parents who are looking for an opportunity to keep their children in school past 4.15pm, we are hoping to offer places (subject to staffing numbers) in our After School Club. After School Prices from September for those children who attend after a club will be £8

The pricing structure for clubs and After School Club is:

After School Club: £10

Club (£2) then join after School Club (£8) = £10
