Changes to clubs next year

We are currently working on developing a wider range of clubs and booster classes for next academic year. We will have a mixture of teacher, teaching assistant and professional coaches who will lead a wide range of clubs. For these clubs to go ahead we need at least 15 children and will be asking for £2 per session. Monies for clubs will be paid ahead of the club starting. Clubs will run for a term at a time and will run from 3.15pm – 4.15pm. Please note, parents who are looking for an opportunity to keep their children in school past 4.15pm, we are hoping to offer places (subject to staffing numbers) in our After School Club.
