## After School Club and Breakfast Club

Both clubs reopened successfully last week. Huge thanks go to the staff teams for all their hard work setting up the clubs in a different building. Thank you to all parents for your patience and understanding regarding the amendments we had to make due to usual provision due to our Covid risk assessment.

Breakfast Club runs from 7:45 to 8:30. Children will be taken to their classes at 8:30. After School Club runs from 3:15 to 5:45.

Please collect your children promptly as the room needs to be deep cleaned before the next day.

**Drop off and Collection arrangements:** Drop off and collection will be at the main gate. If there is no one at the gate when you buzz for Breakfast Club or After School Club please call the school mobile on 07748039939 and a member of staff will come and open the gate for you to drop off or collect your child/children. Please note that if you are collecting your child from After School Club after 4.30pm you will need to call this number as the office is not staffed after 4.30pm. The places in After School Club cost £10 a day with a reduction to £7:50 for subsequent siblings. Breakfast Club costs £2 a day.

**Please note that we will no longer be able to cater for random drop offs or late collections as the children will need to have been previously booked in before they attend due to our risk assessment. Apologies for any inconvenience this may cause.**
