These children were voted for, by their peers, to represent the view of the class. In their first meeting they got to know each other and then agreed the content of the Anti-Bullying Policy. All of the children are in agreement that bullying should not happen at St Paul's and the KS2 school council members wrote an Anti-Bullying Charter to show this. The children will present this information in a Collective Worship with Mrs Bagnall in November during Anti-Bullying week. Anti-Bullying Policy – we need your thoughts! Mrs Crannitch and the School Council have been working on the Anti-Bullying Policy, they want your thoughts on what you think should happen if your child is being bullied. We think the following should happen:

- Talk to your child and record what they say
- Inform the class teacher
- Arrange an appointment to see the class teacher
- Maintain a regular time to see the class teacher until the matter is resolved

If you would like to add your ideas, please either see Mrs Crannitch in the playground before or after school, or leave a note with the school office. This policy will be put on the website as soon as it is completed. Keep checking this part of the website as we are updating most policies across the school.
