

ENGLISH
READING:

During whole class reading lessons, we will be reading a variety of challenging fiction and non-fiction texts including Black and British and Fly Me Home. We will develop comprehension skills by working on skills such as; predicting, summarising, retrieving information and making inferences about a character's thoughts and feelings which are supported by evidence from the text.

WRITING:

During the Spring term, we will be working on the text, 'Freedom Bird' by Jerdine Nolen, which tells the story of John and Millicent Wheeler, whose parents were sold as slaves and who now live and work on a Plantation. We will work on developing spelling, punctuation and grammar skills, extending our vocabulary and producing different styles of writing including: Writing in role, thought bubbles, dialogue, postcard, recount and poems.

SCIENCE AND COMPUTING

SCIENCE:

Our topics are 'Properties and changes of materials' and 'Living things and their habitats'. We will study how living things have changed over time and adapted to suit their environment. We will also look at different materials, their uses and their properties, as well as dissolving, separating mixtures and irreversible changes

COMPUTING:

Children will learn how to create short videos using the skills of capturing, editing, and manipulating videos.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Alongside our daily collective worship, we will be learning about the different faiths in our local community and exploring different beliefs in our class, school and wider community.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

INDOOR SESSION:

Working with an external coach, we will be developing our gymnastics skills and techniques.

OUTDOOR SESSION:

We will be looking closely at Sports Leadership and children will focus on a variety of leadership skills. They will practice their teamwork and communication skills through these sessions

WELL-BEING

In our well-being sessions we will be exploring the concept of resilience and what it means to us. Children will look at building their own resilience and what skills they need in order to help them.

MATHEMATICS

In our maths lessons, we will work on developing our skills and reasoning strategies in a variety of different contexts. We will also give explanations using mathematical vocabulary to demonstrate our deepening understanding.

We will be studying the following units:

- multiplication and division including multiplying four and two-digit numbers and dividing four-digit numbers by one - digit numbers with and without remainders
- fractions
- decimals and percentages

CAPITAL AND CULTURE

HISTORY / GEOGRAPHY:

We will be learning about the Ancient Sumerians. We will use maps to identify where the Sumerians lived and explain why the geography of the area was so important for them. We will also look at some of their inventions and technologies and see what impact they had on the world both then and now.

ART or DESIGN TECHNOLOGY:

Children will learn about the Standard of Ur and Ancient Sumerian art and produce an image from this ancient relic, using paint, to complete a mural.

MUSIC:

We will be learning some songs associated with Lent and Easter.

SPANISH:

We will be learning days of the week and months of the year.
