As you know, all the children from Year 1-6 have a TT Rockstar login https://ttrockstars.com/



Knowing your times tables off by heart helps the children in all areas of maths throughout their time in primary and then secondary school. Each week in celebration collective worship we share how we are doing in the area (as we play against other schools) and who the top ten rockstars are in school. It is all based on how quickly children answer individual questions. St Paul's are still ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> out of nearby schools with an average time of 1.82 seconds/question. The schools in 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> place are all Secondary schools.
