<u>ENGLISH</u>

READING:

We will read a range of familiar texts that include 'The Story of Flight'. The children will learn a range of new vocabulary and be able to focus on their comprehension skills.

WRITING:

Using texts including 'Tar Beach' by Faith Ringgold and 'Farther' by Grahame Baker Smith, we will be describing settings, thinking about a character's thoughts and feelings, writing letters to persuade and using speech marks for direct speech. We will then write a longer piece of writing based on the texts above.

SCIENCE AND COMPUTING

SCIENCE:

In Science, we will be learning about living things. We will learn to recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

COMPUTING:

The children will be learning about programming and will have the opportunity to show repetition in shape and within games.
